

# Nancy's Prayer

This fly was developed for use on Maine's West Branch of the Penobscot River. I first encountered the fly on <http://www.flyfishinginmaine.com>.

This fly can be fished dry, wet, or both. Start by fishing it dry on a dead drift and then fish it skittered across the top a bit and finally stripped back under water. I've caught fish on all three stages.

Anytime you see caddis on the water this fly has an excellent chance of catching fish!

## **Recipe:**

**Hook:** - Dry #12 - #20

**Thread:** - Brown 6/0

**Tail:** - None

**Body:** - Hairtron Dubbing [picked out]

**Underwing:** - CDC

**Wing:** - Wood Duck Breast feather

**Thorax:** - Hairtron Dubbing [picked out]

**Special Tying Instructions:** - None
